A spin off from Grand Designs, and hosted by Clarke Gayford, this show details the lengths that people will go to get a dream home...without building one. Following the very talented house moving companies as they seemingly do the impossible by transporting massive buildings through some of NZ's gnarliest highways.

MAN EATS WILD-THE OUTDOORS CHANNEL

Editor-May-July 2021

Commissioned to edit six episodes of a brand new show based on the escapades of hunter-chef Mario Kalpou. Given masses of footage shot over a 12 month period, my role was more like a 'Predator' where I had to craft the stories while cutting the footage, select and mix music and then grade the shows ready for broadcast.

TOP ROADS CHINA- SHANGHAI MEDIA GROUP

Director-Camera July 2018 - August 2018

China has undergone unparalleled economic growth in the past 30 years. None more so, than in some of the amazing engineering achievements made to create sensational roads and bridges. My role was to research, script and direct two episodes of a six-part series dedicated to roads that both crossed water and headed skyward.

THE GREAT AUSTRALIAN BAKE-OFF / TAKE ME OUT-FOXTEL-CHANNEL 7

Shooting-Producer April 2018 - July 2018

Based out of Sydney, I travelled around Australia producing and shooting the back-stories for the fifth season of the Great Australian Bake-off and the very first Australian season of the global phenomenon, Take Me Out. This involved liaising with talent, locking in locations, scheduling shoots, writing scripts and fulfilling all aspects of image acquisition.

CHINA'S AMAZING SUPER PLANTS-DISCOVERY INTERNATIONAL

Director-D.O.P January 2017 - April 2017

Working with renowned British botanist, Dr. Mark Spencer, I directed and filmed a show about Spencer's quest to discover the secrets behind some of China's most remarkable plants in Yunnan province. One of the world's most fascinating biological hot-spots, we interacted with people from the Yi and Naxi ethnic groups as they shared their secrets for health and longevity through the traditional use of plants.

MYSTERIES OF THE MEKONG-SMITHSONIAN

Director-D.O.P April 2017 - May 2017

Along with my work on observational documentaries and reality television, I have also directed and shot 'Blue Chip' Natural History shows. For this job I travelled with my own kit to South East Asia, and spent a month shooting various animals, insects and scenery around the Mekong River in both Thailand and Vietnam.

FRONTIER BORNEO-DISCOVERY INTERNATIONAL

Shooting-Producer-Director June 2016 - November 2016

The opportunity to direct and film a show in Borneo for four months was an amazing experience. My role was to follow scientific experts and eco-warriors as they worked to protect the wildlife of Sabah and Sarawak. Often based for weeks at a time off the beaten track, this was a massive exercise in resourcefulness, patience and cunning.

ABALONE WARS-DISCOVERY INTERNATIONAL

Shooting-Director-Editor March 2016 - April 2016

The chance to hang out with the gnarly abalone divers from South Australia as they battled the dangerous water off the Great Australian Bight was pretty cool. Put together from a mixture of observational documentary and scripted story telling, I spent a month with these hardy characters as they battled the elements to collect the precious Abalone.

GIANT PANDA-BORN TO BE WILD-ANIMAL PLANET-FRANCE 5

Shooting-Director-Editor July 2015 -December 2015

In 2014, I made three trips to Sichuan province to produce and shoot a show about China's most revered animal. To say that this assignment was tricky is a massive understatement. Not only did I need to collect enough material to make a 6 part series, as well as a 2-Hour special, the Chinese are massively protective of The Panda and were very concerned that the story I was making wouldn't do justice to the work that they are putting into their breeding program. However, they were extremely happy with the final product, especially as the show featured a panda birth that had never been filmed at one of the breeding centers before.

THE SLUM-AL JAZEERA

Shooting-Editor October 2014 - June 2015

Based in Manila for four months, this experience still rates as one of the highlights of my career. The goal was to shed light on some of the poorest people in South East Asia. The material was all shot from an observational perspective and the show was edited almost entirely in Tagalog, which was real challenge for the series producer and myself.

TOP TEN SHARKDOWN - DISCOVERY

Producer-Director-Editor April 2014 - September 2014

Commissioned for The Discovery Channel 'Shark Week', my task was to create a countdown show from archive footage. This involved researching shark behaviour, scouring archives, finding expert talent, writing the script, filming interviews, editing all the footage, keeping it under budget and making sure that it was a hit on Shark Week.

I SURVIVED -A & E-NHNZ

Editor November 2013 - April 2014

NHNZ made more than 100 episodes of this top-rating cable show and I edited 14 episodes, including a one-off two hour special on the Norwegian Massacre.
